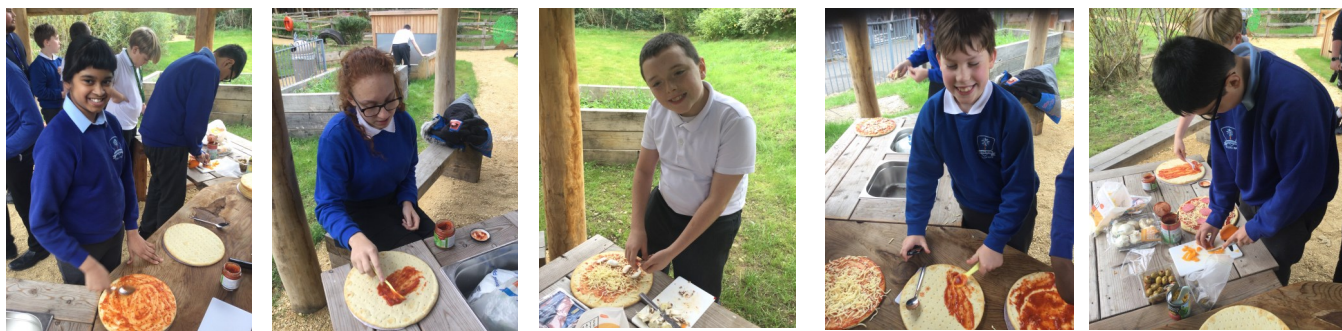

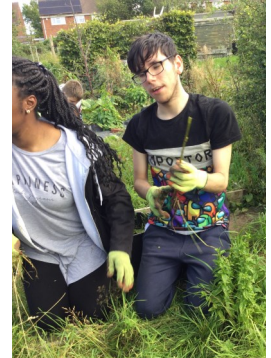
Karaoke Club

Parental Engagement Workshop

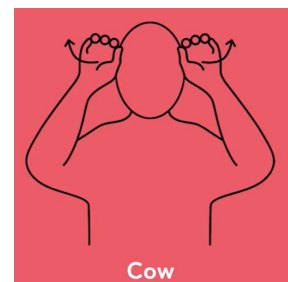
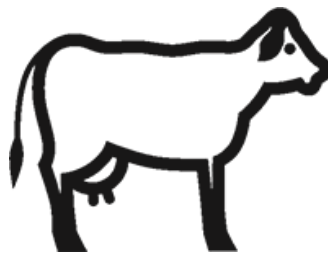
