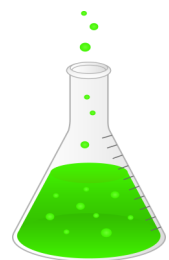
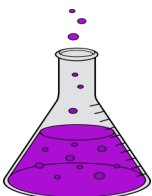
Care, Create, Conserve
