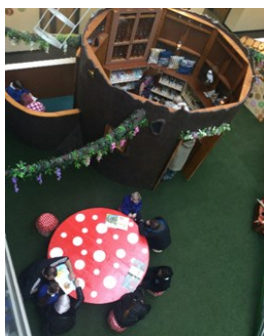
A Walk in the Park
