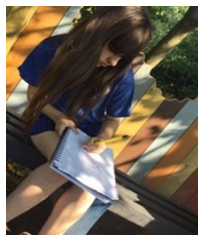

Bilston Market Pop Up Shop Friday 14th July

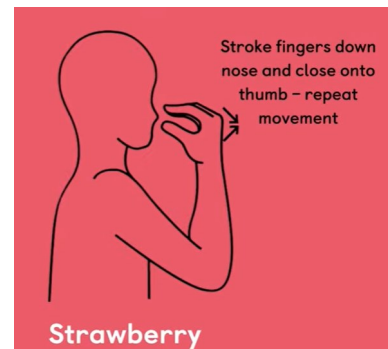
